On the occasion of the memorable anniversary marking the centenary of the outbreak of the First World War, the Faculty of Philology of the University of Belgrade is pleased to inform you that we will organize, from 26<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> September 2014, the international conference on the subject of **First World War in culture and bibliography**. This will be the thirteenth international conference organized by the Faculty of Philology: *The meeting of librarians of the Balkan countries: Cooperation, Education, Quality* (2002), *Intellectual Freedom and Modern Libraries* (2003), *The Economic Role of Libraries in the Modern Society* (2004), *Children and Libraries* (2005), *Leadership in Libraries* (2006), *Information Literacy and Lifelong learning* (2007), *Electronic Library* (2008), *Ethics in Science and Culture* (2009), *The Book and Language* (2010) *Digitization of Cultural Heritage, University Repositories and Distance Learning* (2011), *Cultures in Dialogue* (2012), *Serbia between East and West: science, education, culture and art* (2013). We hope that we have, over the past twelve years, gained your trust, while continuously dealing with current topics in science, culture and education.

This conference will highlight the importance of the First World War, both for the identity of the Serbian people as well as for a common European identity and reflect the findings of scientists from different ethnic, linguistic, political, social and religious communities on all sides of the conflict, including opponents of the war.

The intention of the conference organizers would be to discuss, among others, the following topics:

- Literary and artistic life: 1914-1918;
- Serbian culture in exile;
- First World War in the world and Serbian literature;
- Books and periodicals in the First World War;
- First World War in the bibliography.

Defined topics should contribute to better understanding of the history that goes beyond traditional military history and includes literary, artistic and cultural reinterpretation of experiences from the period 1914-1918.

Faculty of Philology of the University of Belgrade cordially invites you to participate in the conference, with a kind request to send us a brief biographical information, topic, abstract (up to 1,500 characters) and key words of your presentation and register by 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2014 by using the following email address: [fwwcb@fil.bg.ac.rs](mailto:fwwcb@fil.bg.ac.rs).
