The Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) is a Japanese national standardized test that determines the level of Japanese language proficiency of non-native speakers. Having a JLPT certificate is a necessary condition for various scholarships for a study stay in Japan as well as for performing certain activities in that country, especially in the medical profession.

Testing is performed in Japan and around the world at authorized testing centers abroad, and since 2009, the testing has also been performed in our country. The Faculty of Philology of the University of Belgrade, in cooperation with the Japan Foundation and the Embassy of Japan in Serbia, organizes testing **once a year**, in the first week of December (Sunday). Registering and taking the test with us is also possible for citizens of other countries.

The JLPT is a valuable opportunity to measure your Japanese language learning against world standards. Whether you are planning to study in Japan or looking for permanent employment, this certificate will be a strong point in your application.

Registration is done every year from the end of August until the beginning of September at the Group for Japanese Language and Literature of the Faculty of Philology, exclusively through the official forms provided by the Japan Foundation, by which the candidates are officially registered in the central register in Japan and each candidate receives his/her personal registration number.

Exam

The exam is exclusively written and is divided into sections. The language competences tested are grammar, vocabulary, reading and listening. In its current form, the test does not require speaking competence.

The exam contains 5 test levels (N1-N5). The approximate correspondence with the CEFR is as follows:

N5 and N4 = A1, A2 N3 = A2, B1 N2 = B1, B2 N1 = B2, C1

Test results

The test results are published after 3 months, online and in person, by sending a certificate.

Certificate

The certificate is valid permanently. A certificate with a test result can be significant as:

1. Reference for enrollment in a specific educational institution, passing the JLPT is a requirement for the enrollment of foreign students at universities and one of the basic

references when applying for scholarships from the Japan Foundation and the Ministry of Education of the Government of Japan, which are awarded for improving the Japanese language.

- 2. Reference for employers to make easier decisions when choosing future associates.
- 3. An opportunity for all Japanese learners to assess and improve their language skills.
- 4. An opportunity for educational institutions to evaluate the results and progress of their students.
